The Reverend Doctor Dennis R. Maynard is the author of nine books. Well over 100,000 Episcopalians have read his book, “Those Episkopols”. Twenty-five hundred congregations around the United States use “Those Episkopols” in their new member ministries. Several denominational leaders have called it the unofficial handbook for the Episcopal Church. He is also the author of “Forgive and Get Your Life Back” which has been used by clergy to do forgiveness training in their congregations. Maynard has also written a series of novels focusing on life in the typical congregation. These novels have received popular acclaim from both clergy and lay people.

Over his thirty-eight years of parish ministry he has served some of the largest congregations in the Episcopal Church. His ministry includes parishes in Illinois, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Texas, and California.

He has served notable leaders that represent the diversity of his ministry. These leaders include Former Secretary of State, James Baker; Former Secretary of Education, Richard Riley; Supreme Court Nominee, Clement Haynsworth; and the infamous baby doctor, Benjamin Spock, among others.

His most recent endeavors are earning him a reputation as a novelist. The books in “The Magnolia Series” are growing in popularity around the nation as readers anxiously await each new chapter. Look for book five “The Sweet Smell of Magnolia” coming soon.
