Every year at Christmas, there are several families housed in the Care Lodge Domestic Violence shelter, and in order to make the season a little happier for these families, churches and individuals adopt certain projects to provide for the residents.

Care Lodge director, Leslie Payne, has asked that we provide gifts of pajamas and slippers for each resident and in addition, she always needs underwear and socks for children and adult women. Some have asked me if they could provide robes for the person they are buying for and that is certainly welcomed.

In order to know the size and gender of the person you will be providing for, there will be gift tags on the tree with the needed information. Please take one or more gift tags, buy for the person as indicated and wrap the gift (gift bags are ideal) and return it to the tree **with the gift tag displayed on the outside of the package.**

There will also be a box near the tree to receive the underwear and socks items – these do not need to be wrapped – and they can be any size.

The tree will be in the parish hall for two Sundays in December (December 4 and 11). **All gifts should be returned to the tree by December 13**, as they will be delivered to Care Lodge on that date.

Please be generous and help the residents of Care Lodge have a hopeful Christmas.
