Our potential for ministry is greatly enhanced with this addition and we are very excited about the possibilities. In order to be fiscally responsible, the Vestry has formed a group that will oversee the details of bus use and another group will be strategizing fund raising events. We were blessed with a challenge gift of \$5000. We received another \$5000 soon after announcing our challenge. Our total expense will be approximately \$48,000.00. We have a way to go, but with these two generous gifts, we are on our way! I believe that this endeavor will further honor Christ as we serve our brothers and sisters both at the Mediator and in the world.
